Since the last budget committee meeting, added Quickbooks and Costco membership expenses Ms. Johnson noted that money from the County goes very quickly because Blair has so many students and staff and always needs technology and science materials

Drama Boosters money is a pass through (they use the PTSA 501 c 3)

Direct appeal hopes to raise #32,000

We have applications into Montgomery Foundation and looking at other foundations Capitol Steps is expensive. Maybe offer a discount for advanced sales as incentive. Market to neighborhood.

Citrus sale has started

Budget includes summer 2016 expenses (after the FY has ended)

Papa Johns is donating 50 free pizzas. The line item for food at PTSA meeting was cut.

We have \$20K in reserves

The Bliss tutor program needs funding but is not in this year's budget.

We will have a shadow budget should we have surplus funding for other spending.
