FAQs

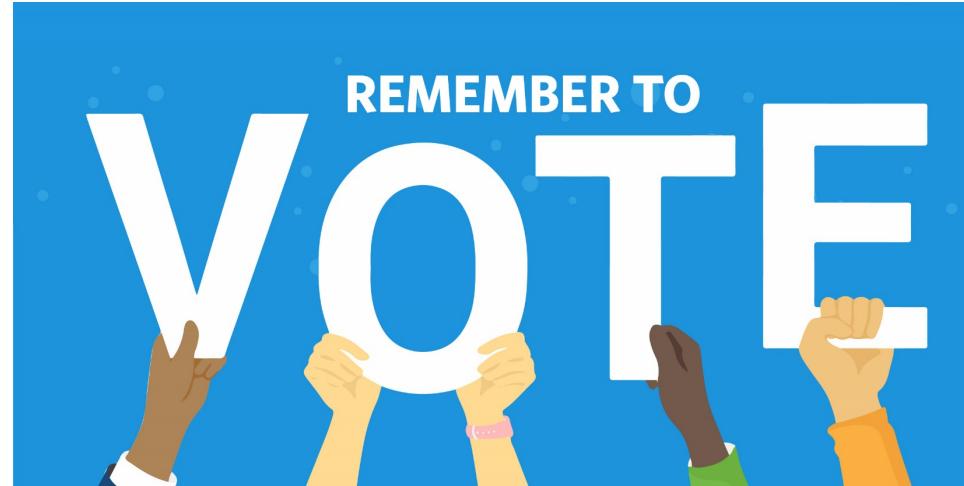
